





National Archives of Malaysia – Recipient of UNESCO/Jikji Memory of the World Award 2009



- In recognition of :
 - outreach, educational and training programmes in the area of preservation within the Asian region.
 - active participation in international activities supporting preservation
 - performing as a key institution in matters relating to preservation and access, establishing itself as a national resource centre for the rescue of documents damaged by flood and fire in Malaysia.
- The following factors were taken into consideration by Jury :
 - the significance of work already undertaken in the area of preservation that is beyond the candidate's regular functions
 - long-term preservation strategy
 - sustainability
 - international outreach.





Outreach, educational and training programmes in the area of preservation within the Asian region and other continents

- Learning institution in the public domain
- Since 1960s Colombo Plan Scholarship
 - offered attachments and practical trainings in conservation and book binding
 - best restoration lab facilities
- Malaysian Technical Co-operation Program since 1984
 - 2 months fully sponsored training course in records management, conservation and book binding for trainees from developing countries
 - >1000 trainees
 - Alumni
- Publication on Guide to Sources of Asian History
 - Nat. Archives of M'sia as key co-ordinator
 - Joint project : UNESCO & ICA
- Datuk Zakiah Hanum, Ex-Director General of Nat. Archives of M'sia winner of Magsaysay Award 1989
 - For outstanding initiatives in promoting and popularizing Archives amongst the people of Malaysia
 - First person in Asia to receive the award for contributions to the Archives profession in the region

Active participation in international activities supporting preservation

 - first regional branch of ICA
 - permanent secretariat at Nat. Archives of M'sia
- First Round Table Conference (CITRA) of ICA in Asia,1982 in Kuala Lumpur
- Assistance to United Nations mission in East Timor, 2002
 - Archivist from Nat. Archives of Malaysia served for 6 months
 - Set up National Archives of Timor Leste
 - Expert advise and training of staff
- Host of the 16th International Archives Congress 2008 Kuala Lumpur

Preventive Preservation

- Repositories
 - Controlled environment
 - Temperature
 - Paper: 20°C ±2
 - Magnetic Audiovisual : 18°C ±2
 - Colour film: 5°C
 - Relative humidity
 - Paper: 50% ±5
 - Magnetic Audiovisual: 30% ±5
 - Colour Film: 25%
 - Security
 - Fire
 - Water
 - Human
 - Shelving
 - Storage Media
 - Ventilation
 - Lighting

Corrective Preservation

- Restoration
 - Deacidification
 - 1993 Nat. Archives of M'sia won the M'sian Public Service Innovation Award for pioneering a new formula for deacidification of archival materials
 - 400g Magnesium Carbonate Carbon dioxide gas (2 hours)
 100 liters of distilled water
 - Process 30 40 minutes
 - Repairs **>**
 - Traditional/manual repair
 - Leaf casting repair
 - Lamination
 - Encapsulation
 - Book binding
 - Cross stitch
 - Saddle stitch
 - Side stitch
 - French sewing
 - Overcasting
 - Sewing on tape
