Rationale and Objective for Case Study

- Organizational culture was identified as an important variable for the successful implementation of a recordkeeping & preservation system in both IP2 and IP3
- Develop a consistent framework to analyze the impact of organizational culture on recordkeeping and preservation practices across case studies for TEAM Canada



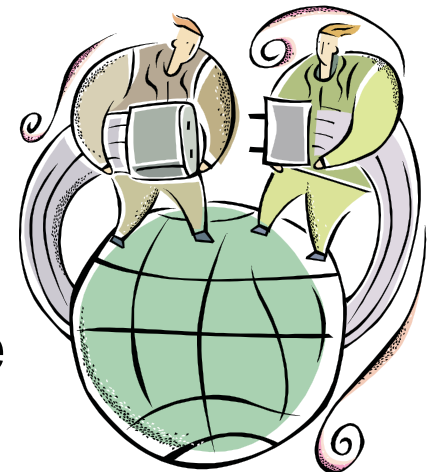
Methodology

- Both deductive and inductive in nature
- Conduct semi-structured interviews with stakeholders:
 - : records creators
 - : records managers and/or archivists
 - : IT department
 - : management
- Triangulate interviews with documentary sources from various case studies



Perspectives in Viewing Culture

- System of ideas and beliefs
 - “differences in collective mental programming found among people from different organizations, or parts thereof, within the same national context”
- Socio-cultural system
 - “culture as an abstraction from innumerable occurrences where people act in complex social and physical contexts”



Concepts & Emerging Themes

- The environment eg: hiring policy and staff turnover affects recordkeeping culture
- Lack of shared perception and belief with regard to the concept of a record and the roles and responsibilities of recordkeeping
- Lack of incentive culture or system of recognition for individuals who champion records management



Concepts & Emerging Themes

- Record creators are not aware of the importance of RM and how it can support their business requirements
- Records creators have difficulties in comprehending the language of records management. Records managers and archivists should be conscious in the use of language to represent an institutional reality eg: recordkeeping and preservation system



Next Steps

- Conduct interviews with Canadian organizations outside of TEAM Canada
- Coding and analysis of interviews and documentary sources based on emerging themes
- Environmental scan and analysis of test bed
- Develop policies and strategies for developing a recordkeeping culture
- Develop risk assessment model
