TEAM-K Research Purpose



- To check validity of IP 1 & 2 principles and guidelines by applying them to TEAM-K testbeds.
- To analyze and compare RMS and AMS guidelines developed in Korea with IP 1 & 2 findings.
- To provide migration guidelines for the long-term preservation based on the lessons learned from actual testing and problems encountered in running testbeds.
- To develop standard test procedures and checklists for effective migration strategies.
- To design environments for testing migration strategies.
- To run migration testbeds and evaluate the results.



Applicability of IP 1 & 2 Findings



- Checking applicability of IP 1 & 2 findings to TEAM-K testbeds:
 - > Applicability of IP policy framework to TEAM-K testbeds.
 - > Applicability of IP creator guidelines to TEAM-K testbeds.
 - > Applicability of IP preserver guidelines to TEAM-K testbeds.
 - > Applicability of IP benchmark and baseline requirements to TEAM-K testbeds.
 - > Applicability of IP file format selection guidelines to TEAM-K testbeds.



TEAM-K Migration Tests



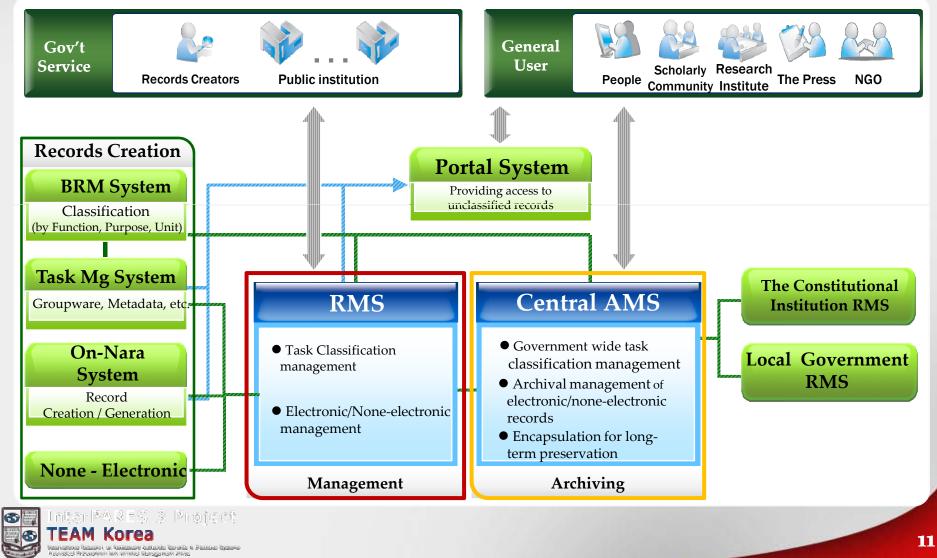
- Only interested in files that are attached as a part of a record.
- Investigate whether legacy files in either resource MS or record MS can be migrated into latest version or a standard document format (PDF/A, ODF, or OOXML)
- Run migration tests on multiple legacy files in a batch mode.

Infrastructure of NAK's Archives/Record Management

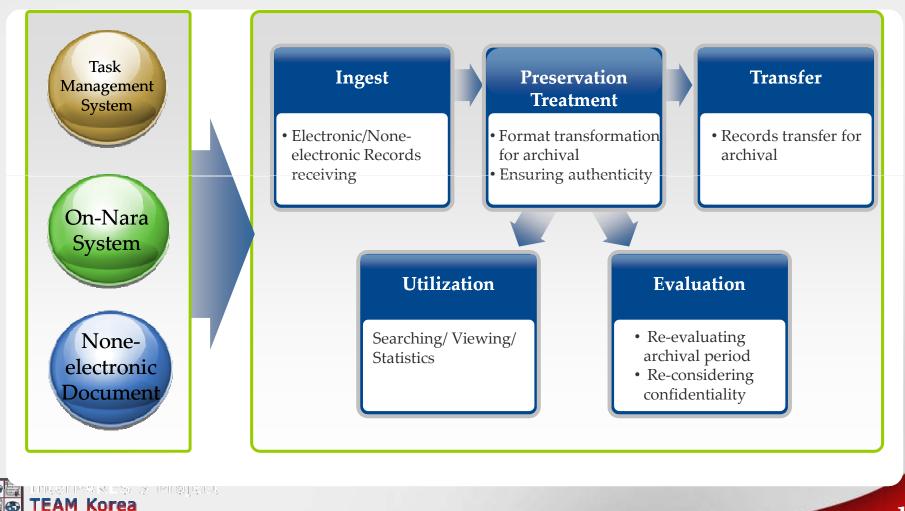


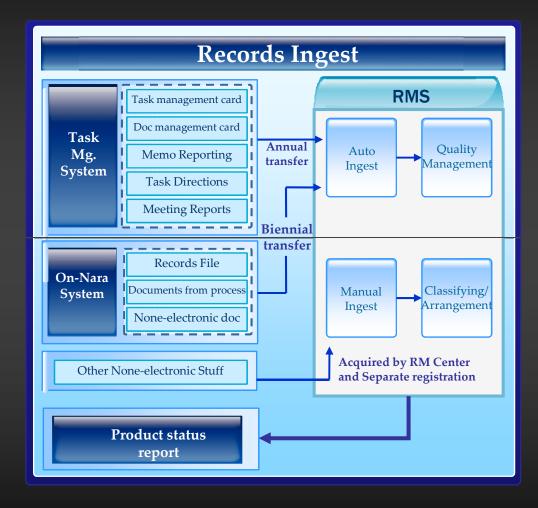

TEAM-K Testbed Partners



Testbed Partners Group 1: Ministry RMS



- Under the leadership of NAK, a standard RMS, interoperable with major record creation systems, is implemented and distributed to central executive agencies (Ministry RMS).
- We will be working closely with those who are professional record managers in each agency to test whether IP 1 & 2 guidelines and baseline requirements are feasible in Korea setting. If they are not, why so?
- We will also investigate whether there are migration issues of files that are attached as parts of records.



Testbed Partners Group 2: KIEC Certified e-Doc Depository

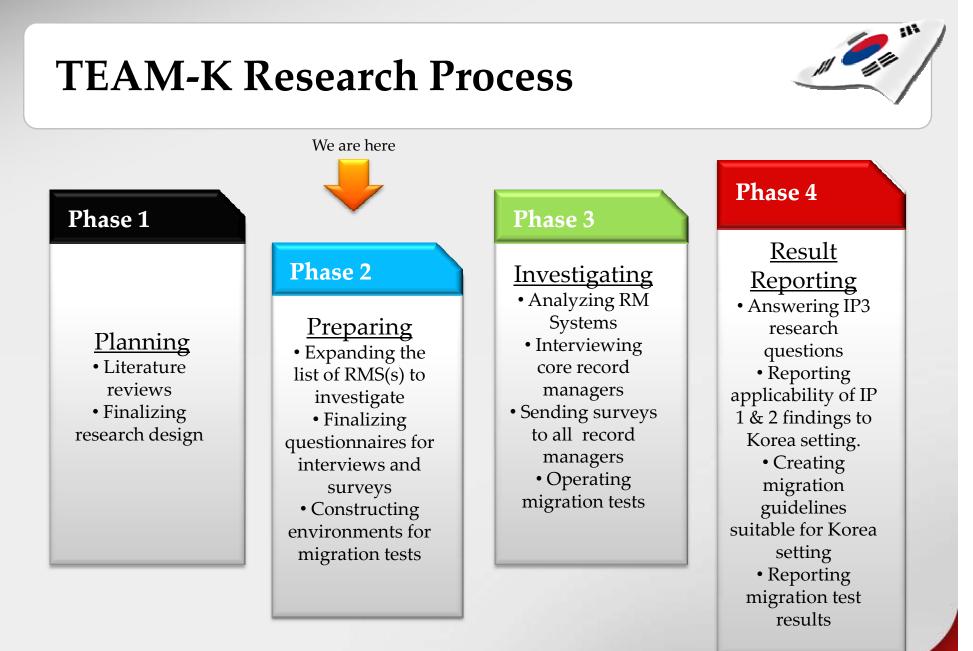


- To test diverse version migration of major document formats, we will investigate legacy files stored in the following institutions:

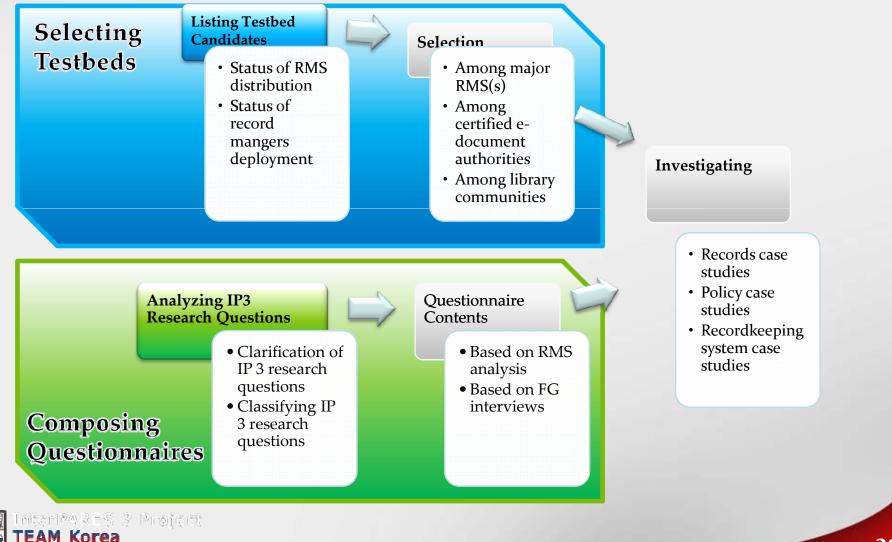




TEAM-K Research Process

TEAM-K Testbed Selection Criteria



- Public/Private institutions that have RMS or similar system.
- Public institution that use RMS developed by NAK.
- Public/Private institutions that employee a professional records managers.
- Institutions that have some understanding of record management and have e-records.
- Institutions that have diverse legacy files.



Applicability of IP 1 & 2 Findings to Korea Setting



- Collaboration work with records managers
 - Considering suggestion from records managers(focus group) about IP 1 & 2 findings and reflect them questions.
 - Indepth analysis of IP 1 & 2 findings by the focus group in public sectors.
- Qualification of records managers
 - Those who received a degree from 8 graduate schools offering programs in RM.
 - Those who received archival and record management training from NAK.
 - The law requires that those who desire to work in RM-related position must have RM certification.



TEAM-K Next Steps



TEAM-K Next Steps



- Composing questionnaires to answer IP3 RQs.
 - > Analyzing IP 3 RQs(records, policy, recordkeeping system case study).
 - > Composing detailed questions for record managers in order to answer each IP3 RQs.
- Interviewing record managers to check applicability of IP 1 & 2 findings to Korea setting.
- Interviewing record managers (Ministry RMS and Certified eDoc Depository) to test draft questionnaires
 - > Revising questionnaires through RMS analysis
 - > Further revising questionnaires based on FG recommendations.
- Conducting a survey research to major record managers to check the applicability of IP 1 & 2 findings to Korea setting.
- Creating migration test environments together with Microsoft, Hansoft, and Unidocs.
- Running migration tests using records files stored in Resource MS (Old RMS) or current RMS.
